AKADEMIYA2063 and KIT Royal Tropical Institute Sign MOU for Impact Research Partnership in Support of Evidence-based Policymaking, Implementation, and Evaluation

Amsterdam, October 21, 2022 – AKADEMIYA2063 and KIT Royal Tropical Institute have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for strategic cooperation in strengthening Africa-based expertise and leadership in support of impact-driven, evidence-based policymaking, implementation, and evaluation. The MOU framework sets out to facilitate cooperation that leverages opportunities for joint research, technical assistance, capacity building, and outreach activities targeting African students, analysts, researchers, and policymakers. The MOU was signed during an event held at KIT Royal Tropical Institute in Amsterdam on October 20, 2022.

"AKADEMIYA2063 is excited to join forces with KIT Royal Tropical Institute to help strengthen data and analytical capacities toward better policy design, implementation, and impact evaluation," said Dr. Ousmane Badiane, AKADEMIYA2063's Executive Chairperson. "This partnership with KIT Royal Tropical Institute presents a unique opportunity for our organizations to leverage our scientific expertise to widen the pool of African researchers working to contribute to the continent's development goals, by providing platforms for training, knowledge exchange, joint research, and outreach," he added.

The thrust of the cooperation will be the development of training and capacity-building activities to be implemented under the African Growth and Development Policy (AGRODEP) Modeling Consortium, a core program of AKADEMIYA2063 and host to a network of over 230 African experts.

"Making impact, by making impact measurable: that is what this partnership is about," said Mark Schneiders, CEO of KIT Royal Tropical Institute. "By combining our expertise in the field of impact assessment and management, we stand stronger in our commitment to contribute to sustainable economic development," he added.

Other projected activities include joint fundraising for research, technical assistance, facilitating knowledge sharing and professional development of staff through secondments and staff exchanges between AKADEMIYA2063 and KIT, and organizing and participating in joint symposia, policy dialogues, seminars, workshops, and conferences related to areas of mutual interest.
