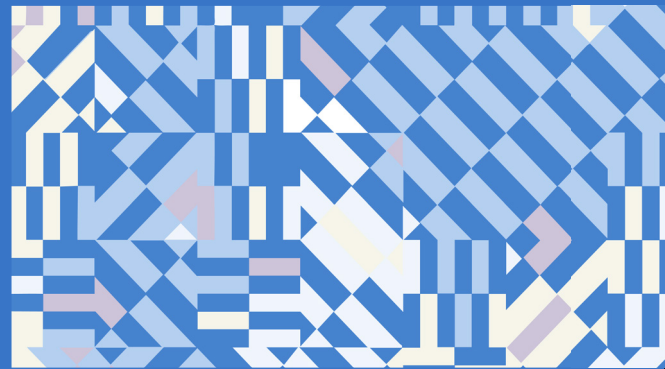
Terms of Trade: Impacts on Growth, Employment, Poverty, and Food Security
