Dr. Moumini Savadogo Appointed Managing Director of AKADEMIYA2063

Savadogo brings over 30 years of experience in agricultural systems, climate change, environmental governance, and sustainable development.

Kigali, August 1, 2023 – AKADEMIYA2063 is delighted to announce the appointment of Dr. Moumini Savadogo as its Managing Director. The organization's Board of Trustees made the announcement early today following a unanimous decision.

Dr. Savadogo, a Burkinabé national, is a transformational leader, senior executive manager, and scientist with over 30 years of experience in the public and private sectors, delivering expertise in agricultural systems, climate change, energy, environmental governance and diplomacy, sustainable development, and nature conservation. Prior to this appointment, he served as Executive Director and Diplomatic Head of Mission at the West African Science Service Center on Climate Change and Adapted land use (WASCAL) since 2018.

Commenting on his appointment, Dr. Savadogo said, "I am very grateful to the Board of Trustees for the opportunity to join such a world-class and timely established African-based international organization dedicated to providing the needed science-asked services for transformative actions towards the **Africa we want**".

With over 55 publications on agriculture, animal production systems, natural resources management, biodiversity, policy, and climate change, Dr. Savadogo's interventions over the last 15 years have focused strongly on science-policy interfaces and advocacy, featuring fundraising, stakeholder engagement and management of governing bodies, and science-policy brokerage activities.

"We are pleased to welcome Dr. Moumini Savadogo as AKADEMIYA2063's new Managing Director and excited for the challenges and milestones which lie ahead," said Dr. Ousmane Badiane, AKADEMIYA2063's Executive Chairperson.
